OPTIONAL DELINQUENCY QUALIFICATION WORKSHEETS

The following sections are provided as a convenience to assist you in determining whether you meet the minimum qualifications established in O.A.C. § 120-1-10 for appointment to various levels of delinquency cases. You are **not** required to submit these sections with your application.

Cases without a Bindover Motion or Serious Youthful Offender (SYO) Proceeding

Unruly, Truancy, Violation of Court Order (VCO), and Misdemeanors		
☐ You must meet ONE of the following to qualify:		
☐ Within two years prior to appointment, a minimum six hours of CLE in juvenile delinquency practice and procedure.		
☐ Successful completion of a clinical education program on juvenile law.		
☐ One year of experience as an attorney.		
Misdemeanor OVI		
☐ You must have, within two years prior to appointment, a minimum six hours of CLE focused on OVI practice and procedure.		
3rd, 4th, and 5th Degree Felonies		
☐ You must meet ALL of the following to qualify:		
☐ Within two years prior to appointment, the following CLE requirements:		
☐ Minimum six hours in juvenile delinquency practice and procedure.		
☐ Additional minimum six hours in criminal and/or juvenile delinquency practice and procedure.		
\Box At least one year of experience as an attorney practicing in juvenile delinquency law.		
1st and 2nd Degree Felonies		
☐ You must meet ALL of the following to qualify:		

☐ Minimum six hours in juvenile delinquency practice and procedure.

☐ Within two years prior to appointment, the following CLE requirements:

$\hfill \square$ Additional minimum six hours in criminal and/or juvenile delinquency practice and procedure.
\Box At least two years of experience as an attorney practicing in juvenile delinquency law.
☐ You must also meet ONE of the following to qualify:
☐ Within ten years prior to appointment, experience as lead trial counsel in at least two bench trials in juvenile court, at least one of which involved a felony-level charge.
\Box Within ten years prior to appointment, experience as lead counsel in one felony bench trial and co-counsel in two additional bench trials.
Murder and Aggravated Murder
☐ You must meet ALL of the following to qualify:
\square Within two years prior to appointment, the following CLE requirements:
☐ Minimum six hours in juvenile delinquency practice and procedure.
\square Additional minimum six hours in criminal and/or juvenile delinquency practice and procedure.
\Box At least three years of experience as an attorney practicing in juvenile delinquency law.
\square You must also meet ONE of the following to qualify:
☐ Within ten years prior to appointment, experience as lead trial counsel in at least four bench trials in juvenile court, at least three of which involved a felony-level charge.
☐ Within ten years prior to appointment, experience as lead counsel in three bench trials, two of which involved a felony-level charge, and co-counsel in three additional bench trials.
Cases with a Bindover Motion or
Serious Youthful Offender (SYO) Proceeding
4th and 5th Degree Felonies with Bindover and/or SYO
☐ You must meet ALL of the following to qualify:
☐ The above juvenile requirements for 4th and 5th degree felonies (without a bindover motion or SYO proceeding).
☐ Within two years prior to appointment, a minimum twelve hours of CLE in criminal practice and

procedure.
☐ At least one year of experience in criminal law.
3rd Degree Felonies with Bindover and/or SYO
☐ You must meet ALL of the following to qualify:
\Box The above juvenile requirements for 3rd degree felonies (without a bindover motion or SYO proceeding).
\square Within two years prior to appointment, a minimum twelve hours of CLE in criminal practice and procedure.
☐ At least one year of experience in criminal law.
☐ You must also meet ONE of the following to qualify:
☐ Within six years prior to appointment, experience as lead trial counsel in at least one criminal jury trial.
☐ Within six years prior to appointment, experience as co-counsel in at least two jury trials.
1st and 2nd Degree Felonies with Bindover and/or SYO
☐ You must meet ALL of the following to qualify:
\Box The above juvenile requirements for 1st and 2nd degree felonies (without a bindover motion or SYO proceeding).
\Box Within two years prior to appointment, a minimum twelve hours of CLE incriminal practice and procedure.
☐ At least three years of experience in criminal law.

<u>Note</u>: Effective December 14, 2022, where an attorney within ten years prior to the appointment successfully completed a trial training program, consisting of 30 hours of instruction or more, the training program will satisfy any requirement in OAC 120-1-10 to serve as: lead counsel in one criminal jury trial and lead counsel in one delinquency bench trial
