ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This matter came on for consideration this 28th day of September 2020 regarding the operations of the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court.

THEREFORE, the Court makes the following finding of fact:

The Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court Administrative Judge acknowledges his authority to be responsible for and exercise control over the administration, docket, and calendar of the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court, pursuant to Rule 4.01(A) of the Rules of Superintendence.

The Administrative Judge further acknowledges his authority to develop and implement a court security plan, pursuant to Rule 9(A) of the Rules of Superintendence.


THEREFORE, the Court makes the following administrative order:

In order to facilitate the efficient and timely disposition of judicial business and promote and maintain the safety and security of all employees and visitors to the courthouse, the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court is hereby ordered closed for business operations beginning Tuesday, September 29, 2020 at 1:00 P.M. and will reopen for regularly scheduled court business and operations on Wednesday, September 30, 2020.

This administrative order shall not apply to the essential operations of the Cuyahoga County Detention Center.

This order shall expire on Wednesday, September 30, 2020.

This order shall be served on the Supreme Court of Ohio, Ohio Judicial Conference, Cuyahoga County Clerk of Courts, Cleveland Metropolitan Bar Association, Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office, Cuyahoga County Public Defender's Office, Cuyahoga County Criminal Defense Lawyer's Association, Cuyahoga County Sheriff, Cuyahoga County Board of Health, Cuyahoga County Executive, Cuyahoga County Council, the website of this court, distributed to the media, and fellow Judges of the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court.
