PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS



Youth Must Meet The Following:

- Be assigned a Home Detention or Probation Officer
- Moderate to High Risk on the Dispositional OYAS
- Be age 14 or older
- Male Only

EXCLUSIONARY CRITERIA



Youth Will NOT Be Accepted If:

- They are Low Risk on the OYAS.
- They present with only:
 - Sexual offending behaviors
 - Developmental Disabilities
 - TBI
 - IQ Below 71
 - Autism Spectrum Disorder
 - Active Psychosis
 - Suicidal or homicidal gestures
- They are enrolled in the Safe Harbor Docket
- They do not have a stable residence.

Program can NOT run concurrent with other programs such as MST or IOP

OUR TWO PROGRAM TRACK



Full Day Track:

- Youth picked up and dropped off at home
- Schedule:
 - Monday-Friday: 7 AM pick-up and 6:30 PM drop-off.
- School of One (CMSD) on-site education
- Group participation
- Access to a case manager (Applewood)

Half-Day Track:

- Youth picked up from school and dropped off at home or school.
- Schedule:
 - Monday-Friday: After school pick-up and 6:30 PM drop-off.
- Group participation
- Access to a case manager (Applewood)

TARGETED PROGRAM LENGTH



Between 10 to 12 weeks but can vary based on the needs and progress of the youth.

PROGRAM TRACK CURRICULUM



Cognitive-Behavioral Interventions for Offenders- Comprehensive Curriculum (CBI-CC)

- Groups will allow for skills role-play and feedback, modeling prosocial behavior and thinking, participating in group interventions and completion of homework to address risky thinking.
- The CBI-CC Modules are as follows:
 - Motivational Engagement
 - Intro to Cognitive Behavioral Interventions
 - Cognitive Restructuring
 - Emotional Regulation
 - Understanding Behavior Patterns
 - Choosing Behavior Responses
 - Problem Solving
 - Panning your Future
 - Success Planning
 - Gangs*
 - Peers*
 - Violence*
