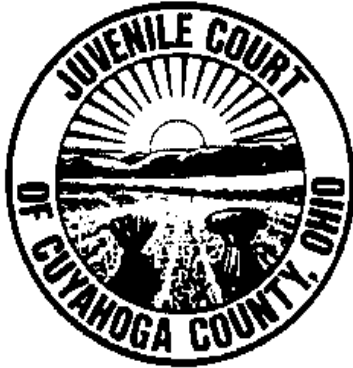

Conditions of Probation

The Judges of the Court have ordered that your probation shall have certain conditions. They have extended the privilege to you because they believe that supervision will help you stay out of trouble and avoid another appearance in Court. They want the Probation Officer to help you respect other persons, their rights and their property. Any violations of the conditions of probation – or further misbehavior – may subject you to the revocation or loss of your probation. The result might be that you would be committed to a correctional or training school. Therefore, observe the following:

1. Conduct yourself according to the laws of this State, the United States, and any ordinances of the City or Village in which you live.
2. Obey your parents, teachers, guardians, or custodians.
3. Conduct yourself in such a way as not to injure the morals or health or yourself or others.
4. Choose your friends carefully. Help with chores at home.
5. If you want to go somewhere, you must provide your parents with information on where you plan to be and when you will be home. Parents/Guardians' permission is required.
6. If you are going to be away from home overnight, you must get permission from your parents and Probation Officer before you go. If you are going out of town, you must contact your Probation Officer before you leave.
7. All activities are subject to curfew as set down by your parents and

Probation Officer. Your curfew time is _____ p.m. Sunday through Thursday, and _____ p.m. Friday and Saturday.

8. You are to attend school regularly and on time. Good behavior: in the school and classroom is expected. If you leave school early, you must go directly home. Illness is to be reported to the school officials and Probation Officer by 8:30 a.m. and verified by parents.
9. You are not to use, be in possession or sell drugs or alcohol.
10. You are to submit to drug testing at the Probation Officer's direction.
11. Keep appointment with your Probation Officer and/or Volunteer Assistant, and be on time.
12. You may be monitored by an electronic device to ensure your compliance with the Conditions of Probation.
13. Voluntarily submit to D.N.A. Testing as required under Ohio Law.
14. The Court has ordered you to observe the following additional conditions of probation:
